In Seodaemun (West Gate) prison. The abductee was seen by the abductee's friend who escaped the prison.

The abductee was a president of the Seoul Electric Corp., which was located in the 5-story building at Chungmuro 2-ga. On the 4th of August 1950, around lunch time, a few of NK soldiers came and asked for the president, who is the abductee. When he appeared they took him by his arms. At night of that day, about midnight, there was a knock on the door. The abductee's fifth son went to the door and NK soldiers aimed guns at him and there was a Jeep car where the abductee was seated at the back seat. The son cried out, "Daddy" but NK soldiers struck the boy and the abductee also gave up coming out. Since then, the son, who is the testifier of this description, have not seen the abductee.

<u>The abductee was involved in the Rep. of anti-communist Korea Young Men's Association (a rightist group)</u> and was a president of Seoul Electrical Company and was active in social activities; among others, he received a letter of Appreciation from the President of ROK, Syngman Rhee. People who abducted the abductee were wearing. North Korean soldier uniforms, riding in army jeep.

<u>Followed are the abductee's carrer: High school graduate / president of Koran electric business. The abductee had a wife and 9 children. His hight was 175cm, and he wore glasses. He had gentle nature.</u>

<u>i) After the outbreak of the Korean War(1950-1953), many neighboring houses of the abductee's house turned</u>
 <u>out to be leftists. The abductee's family implored neighbors' help and found out that the abductee was in</u>
 <u>Seodaemun Prison. The family went to meet the abductee, but they were not allowed. The family confirmed that</u>
 <u>abductees, at that time, stayed in Seodaemun (West Gate) Prison.</u>

ii) Also on June 25-Aug 31, 1964, the Chosun tribune newspaper and Korean National Red Cross collaboratively carried out a "One million signature-collecting campaign for Korean War Abductees' Repatriation", and it was submitted to the United Nations, but turned down because the wartime civilian issues were deemed to fall under the jurisdiction of the International Committee of the Red Cross.

iii) Also, abductee's name have been included in the US Central Intelligence Agency(CIA) report 'Persons Arrested in Seoul by the North Koreans', which was about 654 number of abductees in Seoul, written in Oct 15, 1950.

iv) Dec 13, 2011, KWAFU advocates the drafting and passing of House Resolution 376, a U.S. congressional House resolution.

A special law pertaining to the Korean War abductions finally legislated in March 2010, and the National Committee on Investigating Abductions during the Korean War was established with the Prime Minister as chairman. This new law stipulates government to compile an updated list of abductees based on petitions submitted by surviving family members of the abductees.
